The Christmas Luncheon was thought to have been, by many attending, the best for a long time! Congratulations and thanks again to Sue and all her helpers.

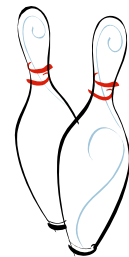
Events
